# **Hobgoblin Ruby 4.5% (Ruby)**


Sweet caramel with fruity fig aromas and taste

#### **Gorgeous George 4.2% (Amber)**


A glowing copper best bitter with spicy hops

A Juicy hoppy session IPA with Mosaic, Citra and Columbus Hops
